Dr. Christine Ehlig-Economides is Professor and Hugh Roy and Lillie Cranz Cullen Distinguished University Chair at the University of Houston. Previously, Dr. Ehlig-Economides taught at Texas A&M University for ten years and worked at Schlumberger for twenty years. At A&M, she managed research in production and reservoir engineering in conventional and shale reservoirs in the petroleum engineering department. Dr. Ehlig-Economides was elected to the U.S. National Academy of Engineering in 2003, was a member of the National Academy of Science Committee on America's Energy Future, and served on the NRC Board on Energy and Environmental Systems (BEES). She chaired The Academies of Medicine, Engineering, and Science in Texas (TAMEST) shale task force in 2017, and is currently a Board member for QRI.
